- 1. Recommend proceeding with design of Berryhill Road (CR184) resurfacing project funded through the FDOT Local Agency Program county reserves.
- 2. Recommend Task Order 29 to contract with CH2M Hill at cost not to exceed \$39,100 for update to Navarre Beach Utility System cost of service and rate study.
- 3. Recommend Task Order to contract with SCS Engineers in the amount of \$32,100 for solid waste rate study and development of business plan for Central Landfill.
