SUBJECT: Adoption of an ordinance amending Lake County Code, Chapter 6, entitled "Buildings and Construction," Article VI, entitled "Locally Registered and Locally Licensed Contractors".

RECOMMENDATION/REQUIRED ACTION:

Request adoption of an ordinance amending Lake County Code, Chapter 6, entitled "Buildings and Construction," Article VI, entitled "Locally Registered and Locally Licensed Contractors"; there is no fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND SUMMARY: Commissioners were approached by a local contractor requesting a "Grandfathering" option to allow a registered contractor who has an active license to make an application to receive a local license for a specialty classification within Lake County. Several years ago this option was available; however, it has since been removed from the County Code.

At the request of the Board, staff has reviewed the issues and is recommending adoption of an ordinance to allow an experienced registered contractor who has an active license with Lake County on or before March 1, 2015 as a residential, building, or general contractor to submit an application to receive a local license for a specialty classification contractor without taking an examination if they meet specific criteria. This exception would expire on March 1, 2016.

24 <u>A registered or certified contractor who has an active license with Lake County on or before March 1,</u>

25 <u>2015 as a residential, building or general contractor shall be allowed to make application to receive a</u>

- 26 <u>license for a specialty classification contractor without taking an examination, if the following</u> 27 requirements are met:
- (a) Submit proof of experience in the form of a notarized affidavit executed by a licensed
 architect, licensed engineer, licensed contractor or building official not related to the
 applicant that the applicant has twenty (20) years of active experience as a craftsperson,
 with ten (10) years of supervisory experience in the specialty classification category in which
 the person seeks to qualify.
- 33 (b) In addition to the application form, each applicant must provide the following:
- 34(1)The appropriate fee for the local license as established by the Board of County35Commissioners.
- 36(2)An affidavit stating that the applicant will not undertake any work which is outside the37scope of the local license for which he/she is applying and that he/she will comply38with all county regulations applicable to his/her work.
- 39 (3) A list of any disciplinary actions against the applicant in any jurisdiction within the last
 40 five (5) years, if applicable.
- 41 <u>(4) Verification that residential, building or general contractor's license is active and in</u> 42 <u>good standing.</u>

- The building official shall issue a local license to each person who meets all of the (c) qualifications of this Section. If the application is denied, the applicant has the right to appeal the decision to the Board of Building Examiners.
- This exception to the licensing requirement shall expire on March 1, 2016. (d)

Section 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase or the Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way effect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Lake County Code and that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section", "article" or such other appropriate word or phrase in order to accomplish such intentions.

Section 7. Filing with the Department of State. The clerk shall be and is hereby directed forthwith to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Secretary of State for the State of Florida.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
