ORDINANCE NO. 2015-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, **RELATING TO VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES,** MAKING REVISIONS TO CITY OF TAMPA CODE OF ORDINANCES, AMENDING CHAPTER 21 (STORMWATER MANAGEMENT); AMENDING SECTION 21-9, PROTECTION OF PUBLIC DRAINAGE SYSTEMS; AMENDING CHAPTER 23.5 (SUPPLEMENTAL ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES); AMENDING SECTION 23.5-5, SCHEDULE OF VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa Stormwater Division desires to protect the City's stormwater drainage patterns and drainage systems by utilizing an effective alternative code enforcement method for violations of Sections 21-8 and 21-9; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa Stormwater Division and Department of Neighborhood Enhancement desire to use the civil citation process as a supplemental means to secure the code compliance process in enforcement of Sections 21-8 and 21-9 of the City of Tampa Code of Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tampa has determined that the following amendments promote and protect the general health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Tampa; and,

WHEREAS, duly noticed public hearings as required by law were held by the City Council of the City of Tampa, at which public hearings all residents and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That "Sec. 21-9. Protection of public drainage systems." is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

"Sec. 21-9. Protection of public drainage systems.

(a) It <u>isshall be</u> unlawful for <u>any individual</u> to introduce any foreign matter (including, but not limited to, trash, leaves, grass clippings, debris, garbage, fill, construction materials, organic or inorganic pollutants, acids, and petroleum
