6	PRESCRIBE A REVISED SCHEDULE OF LANDFILL RATES; UPDATING LANGUAGE RELATING TO TIRE RIM
7	SIZE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION
8	IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10	WHEREAS, Section 38.38 of the Broward County Administrative Code
11	("Administrative Code") sets forth the rate schedule for the disposal of solid waste at the
12	Southwest Regional Landfill; and
13	WHEREAS, in order to improve customer service while reducing the large annual
14	deficit for the operation of the Southwest Regional Landfill, the Broward County Board
15	of County Commissioners desires to amend Section 38.38 of the Administrative Code to
16	revise the rates stated therein, NOW, THEREFORE,
