Amending Article IV of Chapter 25 of the Orange County Code Section 25-140 Tourist Development Plan for an Assurance of Funding for the

Copa America Centenario, and Providing for an effective date

I. EXPLANATION & SUMMARY:

The United States Soccer Federation recently secured the right to host Copa America Centenario soccer games among South, Central and North American teams in the United States for the summer of 2016. Orlando was selected to host at least two games.

On December 10, 2015, the Orange County Tourist Development Council approved a request by the Central Florida Sports Commission ("CFSC") for Tourist Development Tax funding to provide an assurance of funding for up to three Copa America Centenario 2016 soccer matches to be held in the Citrus Bowl in June, 2016 (collectively, the "Copa Games"). The attached ordinance adds a twenty-fourth priority of the Tourist Development Plan to provide an assurance of funding to offset operating deficits associated with the hosting of at least two Copa America Centenario 2016 soccer games at the Citrus Bowl in an amount not to exceed four hundred seventy five thousand dollars (\$475,000.00) pursuant to the terms of a funding assurance agreement.

The funding assurance agreement has been placed on the consent agenda for the meeting of April 5, 2016 and will be pulled for consideration after the public hearing on the ordinance.
