11	Section 1. Section 9-130 of the Code of General Ordinances of the City of Tallahassee,		
12	Florida is hereby amended to read as follows:

14	Sec. 9-130 Training and certification; presence on site of trained applicator during application		
15	of fertilizer.

17	(a) Within 180 days of the effective date of this article and every three years thereafter,		
18	All applicators of fertilizer within the city, other than private homeowners on their own		
19	property, shall abide by and must be certified as provided under this section. To		
20	obtain certification, an applicator shall successfully complete a city-approved best		
21	management practices training program as defined in this article. Upon successful		
22	completion of the best management practices training program and compliance with the		
23 24	requirements in this article, a certificate of completion and a certification card valid for a		
25	period of three years will be provided by the entity providing the training.will be issued		
2 <i>5</i>	to the applicator. For persons certified on or after January 1, 2014, the certification		
27	shall be valid for a period of four years. For persons certified before January 1, 2014,		
28			
28 29	and under the direct and physical supervision of commercial applicators that hold a		
30	current certificate of completion and certification card shall be exempt from the requirement to complete a city-approved best management practices training program.		
31	requirement to complete a city-approved best management practices training program.		
32	(b) <u>During application of any fertilizer governed by this article, the applicator shall</u>		
33	abide by best management practices. At least one person holding a current city-		
34	approved best management practices training certificate shall be present at all times on		
35	any job site while work applying fertilizer is in progress.		
36	any job site while work apprying fertilizer is in progress.		
37	Section 2. Conflict with Other Ordinances and Codes. All ordinances or parts of		
38	ordinances of the City of Tallahassee, Florida, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance		
39	are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

41	Section 3. Severability. If any provision or portion of this ordinance is declared by any		
42	court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining		
43	provisions and portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

45	Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
