Subject: Transportation System Infrastructure Surtax

On April 26, 2016 the City Commission passed a resolution supporting a proposed one cent sales surtax to support infrastructure. Since that time there have been developments between the Broward County cities and the Broward County Commission that will require the Dania Beach City Commission to take certain actions if the City is to continue to act in concert with the cities.

Yesterday, the cities and Broward County came to an agreement on a transportation system and infrastructure sales tax. Major elements of the ILA are as follows:

- ½ cent to Broward County for transportation
- ½ cent to cities for infrastructure
- Infrastructure revenues apportioned by population among cities
- 30 year term
- Infrastructure oversight board

To be consistent with the other Broward County cities, it is recommended that the City Commission adopt the resolution which takes the following actions:

- Repeals the April 26, 2016 resolution supporting a 1 cent infrastructure sales tax
- Approves an ILA for a transportation and infrastructure surtaxes
