Discussion Regarding Property Safety and Maintenance Code County staff has drafted a comprehensive set of regulations entitled the Clay County Property Safety and Maintenance Code (the Draft Code) that, if enacted, would comprise new Article VII of Chapter 6 of the Clay County Code. The Draft Code mandates that all buildings or structures, both existing and new, be maintained in a safe and sanitary condition. A focal point of the Draft Code is the definition of an unsafe building.
