

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS; MAKING REVISIONS TO CITY OF TAMPA CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 15 (PARKING); AMENDING ARTICLE II, REGULATIONS; PERMITS; PENALTIES, DIVISION 4, PENALTIES, SECTION 15-121, PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS; TICKET CANCELLATION PRIVILEGES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa established standards related to Chapter 15, Parking in the City of Tampa; and,

WHEREAS, Section 15-121 of the City of Tampa Code of Ordinances sets forth certain penalties for parking violations and ticket cancellation privileges; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa desires to amend Chapter 15, Parking, Division 4, Penalties, Section 15-121, Penalties for parking violations; ticket cancellation privileges, to allow payment to be made by other forms of payment approved by Resolution upon the recommendation of the Mayor and approved by City Council; and,

WHEREAS, duly noticed public hearings, as required by law, were held by the City Council of the City of Tampa, at which public hearings all residents and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That “**Sec. 15-121. Penalties for parking violations; ticket cancellation privileges.**” is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

“Sec. 15-121. Penalties for parking violations; ticket cancellation privileges.

...(g) Payment made pursuant to this Section may be made by authorized legal tender or other forms of payment approved by Resolution upon the recommendation of the Mayor and approved by City Council.”

Section 2. That should a court of competent jurisdiction declare any part of this Ordinance invalid the remaining parts hereof shall not, in any way, be affected by such determination as to the invalid part.

2 **Section 3.** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are
3 hereby repealed to the extent of any conflict.

5 **Section 4.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon becoming a
