ORDINANCE NO. 2016-

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE TITLE OF SECTION 72.02, "PARKING IN NON-MARKED SPACES," AND DELETING SECTION 72.08, "PARKING NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC," TO CLARIFY REGULATIONS RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, First, the City Commission desires to amend the City Code to clarify regulations related to parking prohibitions; and

WHEREAS, Second, the City Commission finds that this legislation is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Weston.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent and factual findings underlying this Ordinance.

Section 2. Amendment to Chapter 72.

Chapter 72, "Parking Prohibition," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Weston, is amended to read as follows:

§ 72.02 PARKING IN NON-MARKED SPACES PROHIBITED.

No Person shall Park any Motor Vehicle upon any public Street or Right-Of-Way or on any Public or Private Property in other than a space marked for parking with appropriate pavement stripes. This provision shall not apply to residentially zoned properties (and the Rights-Of-Way adjacent thereto), to property actually occupied by a Single-Family Residence, Public Schools, and/or municipal facilities, nor authorized vehicles engaged in the Construction, maintenance or inspection of Roadway facilities or Landscaping.

§ 72.08 PARKING NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC

No-Motor Vehicle , or any part thereof, shall be parked on any travel lane-of-any Public or Private-Right Of-Way .

Section 3. Codification.

It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance become and be made part of the City Code, and that the Sections of this Ordinance and Code may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section" or such other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish such intentions.

Section 4. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Conflict.

That all Sections or parts of Sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, and all Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective u	pon passage and adoption.
