This provision shall not apply to residentially zoned properties (and the Rights-Of-Way adjacent thereto), to property actually occupied by a Single-Family Residence, Public Schools, and/or municipal facilities, nor authorized vehicles engaged in the Construction, maintenance or inspection of Roadway facilities or Landscaping.
