Text of Legislative File 12R-2102

Request Action:

Pass an Ordinance imposing a 120-day moratorium on the receipt, processing or issuance of permits, certificates of use or development orders for group homes within the City of Lauderhill, Florida.

Need:

To provide the city staff with time to study the Guidance on State and Local Land Use Laws related to group housing.

Summary Explanation/ Background:

On November 10, 2016, the U.S. Departments of Justice and Housing and Urban Development Released Updated Fair Housing Act Guidance on State and Local Land Use Laws related to group housing. City staff needs time to study the new Guidance to determing if revisions should be made to the City of Lauderhill Land Development Regulations to address provisions of the Guidance. The City deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of the City of Lauderhill to impose a moratorium on the receipt, processing, consideration, and approval of any new applications or the issuance of any building permits, engineering permits, certificates of use or development orders for group homes within the City of Lauderhill for 120 days from the date of passage and adoption of this Ordinance.
