## **Background:**

On March 22, 2016, the City Commission approved Ordinance No. 604, providing a twelve (12) month moratorium on the submission, processing, or approval of special exception use applications and site plan applications for automobile gasoline stations. The moratorium provided the City time to review its existing and proposed gasoline station sites, the associated impacts, and the applicable Code requirements. In addition, time was provided to prepare revisions to the Land Development Code to address the substantial impacts of automobile gasoline stations on public health, safety, and welfare, as well as vehicular traffic impacts and operational characteristics of gasoline stations. The purpose of the proposed amendment is:

- To remove automobile service as a use and replace with either gasoline station or minor automobile repair throughout;
- Allow gasoline stations as a special exception use in the B-2, B-3, and I-1 zoning districts;
- Revise supplemental regulations for gasoline stations;

- Revise off-street loading requirements for convenience stores;
- To add definitions as used in proposed supplemental regulations.

Staff recommends adoption of the proposed Land Development Code amendment.
