ORDINANCE 2017-229

AN ORDINANCE SECTION 656.1302 AMENDING (DEFINITIONS), PART 13 (SIGN REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 656 (ZONING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, CREATE A NEW SUBSECTION 656.1302(GG) TO ADD A DEFINITION FOR TEMPORARY CITY OF JACKSONVILLE PARKS RECREATIONAL SIGNS; CREATING A SECTION 656.1311 (TEMPORARY CITY OF JACKSONVILLE PARKS RECREATIONAL SIGNS), PART (SIGN REGULATIONS), SUBPART A (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 656 (ZONING CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO CREATE A PUBLIC PURPOSE RECOGNITION FOR TEMPORARY RECREATIONAL SIGNS ADVERTISING SPORTS REGISTRATION FOR PROGRAMMING CITY OF JACKSONVILLE PARKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, over the past 40 years, Americans have expressed a dynamic and accelerated interest in outdoor recreation; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the strong public need for parks and other recreational activities and public purpose areas, the Congress, enacted the Recreation and Public Purposes Act in 1954 (43 USC 869 et seq.)("the Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the lease of public lands for recreational or public purposes to qualified not for profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, active systems of parks and recreational programing provide quality of life and are characteristics of communities where business desire to relocate; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreational programs and services contribute to the health of children, youth, adults and seniors; and

WHEREAS, according to the studies by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, creating and improving and promoting places to be physically active can improve individual and community health and result in 25% increase in residents who exercise at least 3 times a week; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville boasts of over 400 parks both active and passive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville engages with over 46 not for profits to actively program the parks through sporting associations; and

WHEREAS, absent the not-for-profit partnerships, the parks would be utilized on a less frequent basis or alternative the cost to the City to maintain and coordinate the expansive programming provided by the not-for-profits would increase drastically; and

WHEREAS, in order to make prospective sports participants aware of available opportunities, temporary signs two weeks prior to the season may be allowed, subject to conditions and limitations;

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines that the addition of Section 656.1311, allowing Temporary City of Jacksonville Recreational Signs, is necessary and appropriate, that it is based upon careful consideration of the unique function served by not-for-profit organizations using the parks, and that the relaxed location standards are necessary as a result of the public purpose of providing recreational programming through organized sports in city parks; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines that Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs serve an important

function by providing additional information to the public as to the organized sports and recreational opportunities in the parks, and the Council further finds and determines that their placement of such sign types can be controlled and regulated so as to not proliferate unnecessarily; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines and recognizes the important public purposes that are served by allowing Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs and by balancing the community's continuing interests in aesthetics and traffic safety at the same time with conditions and limitations on the placement of the Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs; and

WHEREAS, in view of the findings and determinations contained herein, the Council finds and determines that Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs should be allowed on-site and only within the non-paved portion of the City of Jacksonville park property and park property right of way, subject to conditions and limitations; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines that Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs meet the conditions and limitations as expressly set forth in the new Section 656.1311, including duration, location, spacing, size, height, and permit requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines that signs that do not comply with the City's regulations and/or are found within the City of Jacksonville's right of way other than during the 14 day preceding the season opening should be deemed abandoned, and code enforcement officials shall be authorized to remove and dispose of the same without notice or compensation to the owner, and that such illegal signs be treated as litter under Chapter 741, Zero Tolerance for Litter, subject to the fines and other provisions set forth therein through amendments contained within this ordinance;

and

WHEREAS, the Council finds and determines that the Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign amendment is necessary and continues to provide a balance between the aesthetic and public interests of encouraging programming parks through organized sports in the community, and the functions served by this ordinance, and that it is the intent of the Council that the categorization and treatment of this particular sign-type survive any strict scrutiny analysis under the First Amendment for the reasons outlined herein; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Adoption of recitals as findings.

The Council has reviewed the recitals in the whereas clauses set forth herein and adopts the recitals as findings and in consideration of the Council's intent in this legislation.

Section 2. Definitional Subsection 656.1302(gg) Created. Chapter 656 (Zoning Code), Part 13 (Sign Regulations), Section 656.1302 (Definitions), is amended to create a new subsection 656.1302(gg), providing definitions for Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Signs to read as follows:

CHAPTER 656. ZONING CODE.

(gg) Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign

means a sign, that (1) functions to provide information on

ZONING CODE. 11 12 PART 13. SIGN REGULATIONS 13 14 SUBPART A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 15 Temporary City 656.1311. Jacksonville 16 Sec. of Parks 17 Recreational Signs. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter or the 18 Ordinance Code to the contrary, Temporary City of Jacksonville 19 20 Parks Recreational Signs are hereby authorized for a durational 21 limitation prior to the start of a season under the following 22 conditions and subject to the following limitations: 23 a) Authorized locations. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks 24 Recreational Sign allowed by this section is limited to the Park property on which the Club has a valid License Agreement 25 with the City of Jacksonville to perform park programming. 26 b) Club. Club means a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) association which 27 has entered into a license agreement with the City of 28 29 Jacksonville, Parks Recreation and Community Services 30 Department for use of the city facilities as defined in the License Agreement. 31

- c) Definition. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks
 Recreational Sign means a temporary non-illuminated sign that
 functions to provide registration information for programs
 located at City of Jacksonville Parks and that meets the
 durational limitation, location, spacing, size, height and
 permitting criteria set forth herein.
- d) Display of Permit Number and Date of Issuance. Each Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign that is permitted hereunder shall display on the sign the permit number and the date the permit was issued.
- e) Durational Period. The placement of any Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign allowed by this section is limited to the 14 calendar day period prior to the beginning of the Club Season opening, as specified in the applicable License Agreement.
- f) Height. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign allowed by this section shall not exceed three feet in height measured from the ground level.
- g) License Agreement. License Agreement means an agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the Club by which the Club is authorized to use the City facilities during the Season.
- h) Permit. A person or entity seeking to utilize a Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign allowed by this section shall apply with the Building Inspection Division of the Planning and Development Department, or its successor for, and pay a \$30 fee for, and receive a permit, using the procedures set forth in Section 320.402(d), Ordinance Code, and forms approved by the Building Inspection Division, prior to the placement of any such sign. Each permit shall be for up to as many as five separate Temporary City of Jacksonville

Parks Recreational Signs, for a period of one year. No more than 10 signs per Club shall be allowed during the durational period.

- i) Prohibited locations. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks
 Recreational Sign otherwise allowed by this section is
 prohibited from the following locations:
 - (1) The public right-of-way;
 - (2) A location within 10 feet of a driveway intersection, or within 25 feet of a roadway intersection;
 - (3) Within a sign overlay zone or designated scenic corridor; or
 - (4) A location that obstructs a public sidewalk; and
- j) Season. Season means a period of time commencing and terminating on the respective dates set forth in the License Agreement for the Club.
- k) Size. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign allowed by this section shall not exceed four square feet in area per face.
- 1) Spacing. A Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign allowed by this section shall be spaced at least 100 feet from any other Temporary City of Jacksonville Parks Recreational Sign on the same side of the road.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
