1 CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA 2 ORDINANCE NO. 2017-3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 4 "ENGINEERING PERMITTING PROCEDURES," AND AMENDING 5 SECTION 127.20, "STREET LIGHTS, BRIDGES AND UNDERGROUND UTILITIES;" 6 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 7 8 9 WHEREAS, First, the City Commission desires to amend the City Code to update the City's Engineering Standards; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Second, the City Commission desires to update the City's Engineering Standards 12 to update the permitting procedures and allowable construction methods used in the installation of 13 underground utilities under roadways; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Third, the City Commission finds that this legislation is in the best interest of the 16 17 City of Weston. 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida: 19 20 Recitals. The foregoing Whereas clauses are ratified and incorporated as the 21 Section 1. legislative intent and factual findings underlying this Ordinance. 22 23 24 25 Amendment to Chapter 127. 26 Section 2. 27 Chapter 127, "Engineering Standards," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Weston, is 28 amended to read as follows: 29 30 § 127.10 ENGINEERING PERMITTING PROCEDURES. 31 32 33 34 127.10(H) **Denial or revocation.** Whenever a permit required under this section is denied 35 or revoked because the plan, or the Construction, erection, alteration, modification, repair, or 36 37 demolition is found not in compliance with the requirements of the section and its applicable codes, the City shall identify the specific plan or project features that do not comply with the applicable 38 codes, identify the specific code chapters and sections upon which the finding is based, and provide 39 40 this information to the permit Applicant. 41 42 43 44 § 127.20 STREET LIGHTS, BRIDGES AND UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. 45 46 47

127.20(E) Underground utilities.

* * *

127.20(E)(2) Each underground <u>u</u>Utility crossing of paved <u>roads</u> <u>Roadways</u> shall be made by directional drilling as approved by the City Engineer unless an alternate method, other than those <u>listed in 127.20(E)(2)(a)</u>, is approved by the City Engineer. <u>For Pproposed open cuts</u>, shall be shown on the drawings submitted for approval shall accompany the permit application showing proper restoration of the Roadway and location of the Utility. Written documentation shall be required justifying why the Applicant believes a deviation from the directional drilling is necessary.

127.20(E)(2)(a) Missile boring, horizontal boring, underground pneumatic boring, impact boring, water jetting, air jetting, air rams, thumpers or similar methods for the purposes of installing underground Utilities, conduits, cables and pipes shall not be permitted beneath paved Roadways within Public and Private Rights-Of-Way.

127.20(E)(2)(b) Use of the methods described in 127.20(E)(2)(a) shall be restricted to green areas, beneath driveways and other non-Roadway locations. When not within a dedicated Utility easement, the property Owner's permission shall be required. Any damage as a result of such activities shall be the responsibility of the permittee.

Section 3. Codification.

It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance become and be made part of the City Code, and that the Sections of this Ordinance and Code may be renumbered or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section" or such other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish such intentions.

Section 4. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 5. Conflict.

That all Sections or parts of Sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, and all Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
