

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-45

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO WATER, SEWER AND RECLAIMED WATER RATES; DEFERRING THE INCREASE IN SUCH RATES SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 1, 2017 UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 2018; AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF MELBOURNE FLORIDA, CHAPTER 58, UTILITIES; AMENDING SECTION 58-133, WATER SERVICE RATES; AMENDING SECTION 58-243, SEWER SERVICE RATES; AMENDING SECTION 58-364, RECLAIMED WATER SERVICE FEES; PROVIDING AN INTERPRETATION CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING AN ADOPTION SCHEDULE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 58-133 of the City Code of Melbourne, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 58-133. Water service rates.

* * * *

- (b) Monthly service charge.
- (1) Each customer connected to the city's potable water system shall pay a monthly service charge based on the number of equivalent residential connections (ERCs) and the effective rate per ERC being served at such connection as determined by the city for each potable water customer as defined in the following table:

- (c) Gallonage charge. In addition to the above established service charge, each customer shall pay a monthly gallonage charge per unit for each 1,000 gallons, or portion thereof, of water as metered at the customer's premises in accordance with the schedule set forth below:

SECTION 2. That Section 58-243 of the City Code of Melbourne, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 58-243. Sewer service rates.

* * * *

- (b) Monthly service charge.
 - (1) Each customer connected to the city's sewer system shall pay a monthly service charge based on the number of equivalent residential connections (ERCs) and the effective rate per ERC determined by the city for each sewer customer defined in the following table:

(c) Gallonage charge. Each customer connected to the city's sewer system to whom a monthly bill shall be rendered for water furnished by the city's water system shall pay a charge per 1,000 gallons, or portion thereof, of water passed through the water meter for sewer services in accordance with the schedule set forth below:

SECTION 3. That Section 58-364 of the City Code of Melbourne, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 58-364. Reclaimed water service fees.

(a) All existing customers of reclaimed water who have active accounts on May 1, 2008, shall be charged a monthly service charge for operational and maintenance costs related to producing and distributing reclaimed water as follows:

(b) The rate charged for all new customers of reclaimed water after May 1, 2008, shall consist of a monthly service charge and a monthly gallonage charge.

(1) Monthly service charge. Each customer connected to the city's reclaimed water system shall pay the following listed monthly service charge based on the meter size. The monthly service charge shall include a gallonage allocation for each meter size as shown below:

- (2) Gallonge charge. In addition to the above-established service charge, each customer shall pay a monthly gallonge charge for each 1,000 gallons, or portion thereof, of reclaimed water passed through the customer's service meter that is over and above the gallonge allocation as follows:

SECTION 4. Interpretation Clause. That in interpreting this ordinance, underlined words indicate additions to existing text and ~~stricken words~~ indicate deletions from existing text.

Asterisks (* * * *) indicate an omission from the ordinance of text, which exists in the Code of Ordinances. It is intended that the text in the Code of Ordinances denoted by the asterisks and not set forth in this ordinance shall remain unchanged from the language existing prior to adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption in accordance with the Charter of the City of Melbourne.
