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2 An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the Code of Ordinances relating to solid waste disposal by 3 amending paragraph (e) of section 27-79 to provide for earlier 4 5 solid waste collection times in certain zones; providing directions to the codifier; providing a severability clause; 6 7 providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate 8 effective date. 9 10 WHEREAS, at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper 11 12 of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be 13 held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at 14 15 which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact heard. 16 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:** 18 Section 1. Paragraph (e) of Section 27-79 of Division 2 of Article III of Chapter 27 is 19 20 amended to read as set forth below. Except as amended herein, the remainder of Section 27-79 21 remains in full force and effect. **Chapter 27 – UTILITIES** 22 **ARTICLE III – SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL** 23 24 **DIVISION 2 – COMMERCIAL SERVICE AND CONSTRUCTION** 25 AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS FRANCHISE 26 Sec. 27-79. General provisions. 27 28 (e) <u>Collection times shall be as follows:</u>

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(1) Each commercial franchisee shall make available daily (except Sunday) collection of solid
waste. Collection shall begin no earlier than 6:00 a.m., and shall cease no later than 9:00 p.m.,
Monday through Saturday, except that in areas of mixed residential and commercial occupancy,
where collections shall begin no earlier than 7:00 a.m. and cease no later than 9:00 p.m., Monday
through Saturday.
(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (e)(1), the city manager or designee may set other hours for the
purpose of improving collection operations or safety, by the City first holding a neighborhood
workshop to inform various residents, businesses and other stakeholders of the change being
considered, and to solicit their input. The workshop will be held in a location generally near the
subject area in a facility that is ADA compliant. The City will provide notification by mail to all
owners of property and neighborhood associations within the area being considered as well as
those within 400 feet of the perimeter of that area. The notices will be mailed at least 14 days
before the workshop and the City will also advertise the workshop in a newspaper of general
circulation at least 14 days before the date of the workshop. The workshop must start between
6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on a weekday or between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on a weekend. The
City shall prepare a written summary of the neighborhood meeting that includes a list of those in
attendance, a summary of the issues discussed, and comments, concerns and suggestions by
those in attendance. Any change in collection times shall be established in a written
memorandum outlining the justification. All memoranda establishing collection times, and
summaries of the neighborhood meetings, shall be retained on file by the Solid Waste Division
and made available to the public for inspection. These collection times should be reviewed
periodically to determine whether the operational justification continues to exist.

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(3) Notwithstanding paragraph (e)(1), tThe city manager or designee may authorize collection 1 on Sunday where special needs of the customer make it necessary. In the event of an emergency, 2 3 a franchisee may collect at times not allowed by this section, provided the city manager grants prior approval, to be later evidenced by a written memorandum. If no written memorandum is 4 5 obtained, there shall be a presumption that the franchisee had not obtained prior approval. All 6 written memoranda issued shall be retained on file by the Solid Waste Division and made available to the public for inspection. 7 8 Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of 9 this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the sections and paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered 10 11 or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions. 12 Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such 13 finding shall not affect the other provisions or application of the ordinance which can be given 14 15 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable. 16 17 Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of 18 such conflict hereby repealed. 19 Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption. 20
