The updates provide greater clarity of language for building permit reviews and proposed land development; adds more definitions; provides for the creation of a planned development; and combines all sections related to the management of stormwater into a new chapter within the land development code rather than in a separate appendix.

The updates are intended to revise and clarify some outdated language and improve the ability of citizens to understand land development regulations within the City. The changes are summarized below.</li> <li>Chapter I Purpose and General Provisions         <ul> <li>Section 1-20, some definitions were added and others were clarified or deleted</li> <li>Section 1-40, some language related to Board alternate positions was revised.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Chapter II Zoning Districts</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Section 2-26, the language related to the creation of a special development overlay district was deleted and replaced with guidelines for the creation of a planned development (PD).</li> <li>Chapter III Design Standards         <ul> <li>All sections were reorganized for improved organization, language was clarified and outdated requirements were revised.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Chapter IV Application and Review Process         <ul> <li>Section 4-01, the site plan submittal procedures were revised</li> </ul> </li> <li>Chapter VI Stormwater Management and Flood Control         <ul> <li>A new chapter within the LDC, which was created by relocating Appendix C and moving the stormwater and erosion control sections from Chapter III.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
