**SUBJECT**

Public Hearing to consider adoption of an ordinance amending Polk County Ordinance 86-35 "Polk County Parking Ordinance" to prohibit parking of vehicles with a payload capacity exceeding 2 tons on rights-of-way.

**DESCRIPTION**

The proposed ordinance would amend the Polk County Parking Ordinance ("Parking Ordinance") to prohibit the parking of vehicles with a payload capacity exceeding 2 tons on rights-of-way. It would also amend the Parking Ordinance to allow enforcement by the Sheriff Office or Code Enforcement. Lastly, the proposed ordinance amends the penalty section of the Parking Ordinance to require a written warning for the first violation and then imposing increased fines from \$100 to \$500 for repeat violations, except for violations for parking in a designated "handicapped" parking space which requires a fine of \$100 for all violations.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt the proposed ordinance amending Polk County Ordinance 86-35 "Polk County Parking Ordinance" to prohibit parking of vehicles with a payload capacity exceeding 2 tons on rights-of-way.
