RE: Discussion and Possible Action Establishing Miami Shores Single Use Plastic and Paper Bag Reduction Program

Community Plastic Reduction Workshops were held at the Community Center on May 20 and June 9. The main idea of the workshops was summarized by the following: Ban Plastic Bags? Ban Plastic Straws? Ban Nothing? Begin Bag Fees? Do Something? Do Nothing?

In addition to providing an open forum giving residents the opportunity to be heard on the issue of plastic reduction, presentations were made by Scott Davis, Miami Shores Public Works Director (Miami Shores Recycling Program), Dorothy Campbell, Surfrider Foundation Miami and Miami Shores Resident (Rise Above Plastics Program), John Ise, Biscayne Times Columnist and Miami Shores Resident (Paying for Our Fair Share of Trash) and Aaron Kleinert, CEO - StrawFish.co (Sustainable alternatives to single-use plastics).

The Miami Shores residents in attendance were unanimous and enthusiastically in support of the Village Council taking action to reduce plastic. Accordingly, I decided to bring this issue to the Council Agenda for discussion and possible action.

Consideration

Upon review of the available resources and authorities, it appears the most effective action would be to implement a bag fee on both single-use plastic bags and single-use paper bags with fee exemptions for appropriate individuals. The fees collected would go to a Miami Shores Environmental Fund.
