17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:
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19 Section 1: The foregoing recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by
20 reference herein.
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22 Section 2: The proposed millage rate approved for the taxation of all real and personal property lying
23 within the boundaries of the City of Weston, Florida shall be 3.3464 mills per \$1,000.00 of assessed
24 property value for the Fiscal Year 2021.
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26 Section 3: The percentage by which the millage rate to be levied is 3.41% above the rolled back
27 rate of 3.2360 mills [computed pursuant to F.S. 200.065 (1)] and 0.19% above the rolled back millage
28 rate adjusted for change in per capita Florida personal income of 3.3402 mills as set forth herein.
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30 Section 4: The City Clerk is directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Broward
31 County Property Appraiser, the Broward County Revenue Collector, and the Florida Department of
32 Revenue.

34 Section 5: A decision by a court of competent jurisdiction declaring invalid any section, paragraph,
