10 11	WHEREAS, First, on January 12, 2021, Florida Representative Anna V. Eskamani filed House Bill 6023, seeking to protect home rule powers and repeal a state preemption of local
12 13	ordinances relating to trees located on residential properties; and
14 15	WHEREAS, Second, on January 13, 2021, Florida Senator Linda Stewart filed companion bill, Senate Bill 596; and

1 <i>7</i> 18	WHEREAS, Third, Senate Bill 596 and House Bill 6023, if passed, would repeal Section 163.045, Florida Statutes, and would restore the rights of local governments related to pruning
19 20	trimming or removal of trees on residential property; and
21	WHEREAS, Fourth, under the Florida Constitution and Section 166.021, Florida Statutes
22 23	municipalities are given broad home rule powers; and
24	WHEREAS, Fifth, as part of their home rule powers, municipalities should have the ability to protect their resources; and

27	WHEREAS, Sixth, municipalities should continue to have the power to decide what is consisten

163.045 Tree pruning, trimming, or removal on residential property.—

- (1) A local government may not require a notice, application, approval, permit, fee, or mitigation for the pruning, trimming, or removal of a tree on residential property if the property owner obtains documentation from an arborist certified by the International Society of Arboriculture or a Florida licensed landscape architect that the tree presents a danger to persons or property.
- (2) A local government may not require a property owner to replant a tree that was pruned, trimmed, or removed in accordance with this section.
- (3) This section does not apply to the exercise of specifically delegated authority for mangrove protection pursuant to ss. 403.9321-403.9333.
