BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

City Council Adopted Ordinance No. 3905 on October 5, 2020, establishing a fee to be charged for reclaimed water. The fee is a partial recovery rate. The City contracted with Stantec, Inc., the City utility rate consultant, to perform an analysis of the cost to produce reclaimed water. The results of the study were presented in a workshop. There was no increase for Fiscal Year 2021, and a 10% rate increase was proposed for Fiscal Years 2022 through 2026 respectively. On September 20, 2021 City Council approved Ordinance 3922 confirming the 10% increase, however, due to an administrative oversight, the public hearing advertisement was not properly done. Ordinance No. 3927, rescinds Ordinance 3922 and confirms the 10% increase in the reclaimed water rate for Fiscal Year 2022. Fiscal Years 2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026 will increase 10% respectively over the rates for Fiscal Year 2022.
