12 13 14 15	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Town Commission hereby finds it is in the best interest of the Town to amend the Town Code of Ordinances, by specifically amending Chapter 12 related to appropriate plant selection, location and arrangement;
16 17	<b>WHEREAS,</b> the Town Commission deems it in the best interest of the Town to allow for the use of artificial turf under specific conditions.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF HILLSBORO BEACH, FLORIDA THAT:
19 20 21	<b>Section 1</b> . The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance.
22 23 24 25	<u>Section 2</u> . Chapter 12 entitled "Land Development Code" of the Town's Code of Ordinances, specifically Section 12-396 entitled "Appropriate Plant Selection, Location, and Arrangement" is hereby amended as follows:
23 26 27	Sec. 12-396 - Appropriate plant selection, location and arrangement.
28 29 30 31 32 33	(M) The use of artificial plants and vegetation <u>turf</u> shall be substituted for natural plants and vegetation <u>turf grass</u> only in those instances where an <u>conditional use</u> application is filed by the property owner and the application is approved by the Town <del>Commission</del> Administrator or designee for single-family residences within the R-2 Zoning District. The conditional use allowing for the use of artificial plants and vegetation <u>turf</u> for landscaping shall be subject to the following:
34 35 36 37 38 39 40	<ul> <li>(1) Procedure. Artificial Turf Permit required. All conditional uses shall be subject to approval of the Town Commission, and no conditional use shall be approved until after a public hearing by the Town Commission, at which time all interested parties shall have an opportunity to be heard. The Artificial Turf Permit application shall include, at a minimum, the following information:         <ol> <li>A site-landscape plan of the intended area of installation showing the location of the artificial turf, area of living plant material, and and method of separation between</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

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1	these areas. All other minimum landscape requirements for the property shall be
2	required.
3	2. Details regarding existing or proposed irrigation proximate to the artificial turf.
4	3. Brand and type of artificial turf including all manufacturer specifications and
5	warranties. If not currently used within the Town, the application shall also include a
6 7	sample of the material to be installed. <u>4. A scaled cross section and details of the proposed materials and installation, including</u>
8	<u>4. A stated cross section and details of the proposed materials and instantation, including</u> but not limited to subgrade, drainage, base or leveling laver, and infill.
9	(2) Review criteria. The Town Manager or his or her designee Commission shall not
10	approve <del>a conditional use,_unless and until it finds that<u> the use of artificial turf based</u></del>
11	on compliance with the following criteria:
12	(a) The use of artificial plants and vegetation is deemed desirable for the public
13	convenience or welfare, and the use is in harmony with the purpose and intent of
14	this chapter and will not be detrimental or injurious to the town.
15	(b) When granting approval for a conditional use, the Town Commission may attach
16	conditions and safeguards, as it may determine is necessary for the protection and
17	aesthetic appearance of the town.
17	destricte appearance of the town.
18	<del>(c)[a] <u>Design Standards.</u> The application shall meet all of the following <del>criteria<u>design</u></del></del>
19	standards, and shall-where appropriate:
20	1. Harmony with adjacent uses (existing or zoned). Simulate the appearance of
21	live turf, organic turf, grass, sod or lawn, and shall have a minimum eight (8) year
22	"no fade" warranty.
23	2. Use not hazardous to the town. Have a minimum face weight of 75 ounces per
24	square yard.
25	3. The landscape plan identifying the location and dimension of the use of artificial
26	plants and vegetation is compatible with the character and aesthetics of the
27	town. <u>Be manufactured from polyethylene monofilament, dual yarn system, and</u>
28	manufactured in the United States.
29	4. Have backing that is permeable.
30	5. Be lead free and flame retardant.
31	<u>6. Be of a type known as cut pile infill with pile fibers of a minimum height of 1.75</u>
32	inches and a maximum height of 2.5 inches, except for Putting Greens, which may
33	have a minimum height of ¼ inch.
34	
35	(b) Installation Standards. Artificial turf shall comply with all of the following
36	installation standards and shall:
37	1. Be installed by a Florida-licensed general contractor in a manner prescribed by
38	the manufacturer.
39	2. Be installed over an evenly graded, porous crushed rock aggregate material that
40	is a minimum of three inches in depth.

1	3. Be anchored at all edges and seams consistent with the manufacturer's
2	specifications.
3	4. Not have visible seams between multiple panels.
4	5. Have seams that are joined in a tight and secure manner.
5	<u>6. Be a minimum of six feet from a tree or palm and 12 inches</u>
6	from hedges, shrubs, or groundcover, including the separator.
7	7. Have an infill medium consisting of clean silica sand or other mixture, pursuant to
8	the manufacturer's specifications that shall:
9	a. Be brushed into the fibers to ensure that the fibers remain in an upright
10	position;
11	b. Provide ballast that will help hold the Synthetic Turf in place; and
12	c. Provide a cushioning effect.
13	(c) Additional Standards. Artificial turf shall comply with all of the following
14	installation standards and shall:
15	1. Areas of living plant material shall be installed and/or maintained in
16	conjunction with the installation of Synthetic Turf. Living plant material shall be
17	provided per the minimum code requirements.
18 19	<ol> <li>Irrigation systems proximate to the Synthetic Turf shall be directed so that no Irrigation affects the Synthetic Turf.</li> </ol>
20	(d) Maintenance Standards. Artificial turf shall comply with all of the following
20	maintenance standards and shall:
22	<u>1. Be maintained in an attractive and clean condition, and shall not contain holes,</u>
23	tears, stains, discoloration, seam separations, uplifted surfaces or edges, heat
24	degradation or excessive wear.
25	2. Be maintained in a green fadeless condition and free of weeds, debris, and
26	impressions.
27	(e) Prohibitions. Synthetic Turf shall not be used as a screening material where
28	screening is required by the Code.
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30	(3) Conditional use approval amendments. A conditional use approval is specific to the
31	landscape plan and any supplemental conditions approved. Modifications to any of the
32	specifics or conditions of the approval shall be deemed a code violation and subject to
33	code enforcement action and/or revocation of the conditional use approved.
33	toue enforcement action and/or revocation of the conditional use approved.
34	(4) Each application for a conditional use under this section for artificial turf shall be
35	submitted with a landscape plan and accompanied by a check made payable to the town
36	in an amount set from time to time by resolution adopted by the Town Commission to
37	offset administrative fees and costs.
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39	<b>Section 3</b> . If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is
40	held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.
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42	<b>Section 4</b> . That all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of
43	resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
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1	<b>Section 5.</b> It is the intention of the Town Commission of the Town of Hillsboro Beach,
2	that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of
3	Town of Hillsboro Beach, Florida, and the Sections of this ordinance may be renumbered, re-lettered
4	and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section," "Article," or such other word or phrase in
5	order to accomplish such intention.
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7	<b>Section 6.</b> This Ordinance shall be effective after its passage and adoption by the Town
8	Commission of the Town of Hillsboro Beach.
