17	enforced on a twenty-four (24) hour basis; and
18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF HILLSBORO BEACH, FLORIDA THAT:
20	Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as
21	being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance.
22 23 24 25	Section 2. Article VII entitled "Noises" of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:
26	ARTICLE VII NOISES
27 28	Sec. 7-93 Loud and unnecessary noises.
20 29	Seel 7 751 Loud and annecessary noises.
30	(A)It shall be unlawful to create, maintain or otherwise cause any unreasonably loud,
31 32	disturbing and unnecessary noises of such character, intensity and duration as to disturb the public peace and welfare and otherwise be detrimental to the life and health of any
33	individual, within the limits of the town.
34 35	(B)Any person or corporation violating this section shall be fined not less than \$100.00,
36	and subsequent violations shall be fined \$500.00 for each violation, and a separate offense
37 28	shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs.
38 39	(C)Landscape maintenance equipment noise.

1 2	(1)Operation of lawn maintenance equipment shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 am to 4 <u>6</u> :00 pm Monday through Friday and prohibited on Sundays and all legal
2	holidays. Landscape maintenance equipment may be used on Saturdays from 9:00
4	a.m. to 1:00 p.m. only.
5	a.m. to 1.00 p.m. omy.
6	(2)Landscape maintenance equipment includes but is not limited to lawn mowers,
7	edgers, hedge trimmers, yard tractors, leaf blowers, lawn vacuum machines, and
8	monofilament line grass trimmers.
9	monomament mie grass timmers.
10	(3)Landscape maintenance equipment shall not exceed a decibel level of 65 dBA as
11	measured at 75 feet from the point of operation.
12	
13	Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this
14	Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such
15	invalidity.
16	
17	Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts
18	of resolutions in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.
19	
20	Section 5. It is the intention of the Town Commission of the Town of Hillsboro
21	Beach, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of
22	Ordinances of Town of Hillsboro Beach, Florida, and the Sections of this ordinance may be
23	renumbered, re-lettered and the word "Ordinance" may be changed to "Section," "Article,"
24	or such other word or phrase in order to accomplish such intention.

18	Section 2. Article VI entitled "Nuisances" of the Code of Ordinances is hereby

21	ARTICLE VI. – NUISANCES.

23 24	Sec. 6-132 Landscaping. (A)All landscaping, including without limitation trees, shrubs, lawns, flower beds, walkways,
24 25	ground elevations and berms, shall be maintained in a neat, orderly and attractive manner,
25 26	including necessary irrigation, consistent with the general appearance of the developed portions
20	of the town. Trees and shrubs shall be regularly pruned and not be allowed to become overgrown.
28	Lawns shall be mowed on a regular basis as necessary by the conditions. No weeds, underbrush
29	or other unsightly growths shall be permitted to grow or remain upon any part of the property
30	and no refuse pile or unsightly objects shall be allowed to be placed or suffered to remain on any
31	property. Dead and/or diseased plant material shall be removed and replaced with a suitable
32	planting in a prompt manner.
33	
34	(B)No vegetation shall be permitted to extend into the vehicle, pedestrian or bicycle travel lanes,
35	except for tree canopies, which canopies must maintain height clearance for vehicular, pedestrian
36	and bicycle traffic. Any and all landscape maintenance referenced in this section shall not be

undertaken on Saturday or Sunday or national holidays and only between the hours of 8:00 a.m.

1 2	and 6:00 p.m. on all other days. The use of gas operated implements commonly referred to as "leaf blowers" shall be expressly prohibited on Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays.
3	
4	(C) In the event of an emergency such as a tropical event, the Town Manager shall be authorized
5	to suspend the enforcement of this Section and any other Section of the Town Code of Ordinances
6 7	to allow for clean up efforts.
8	Section 3 . If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is
9	held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.
10	held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be uncered by such invalidity.
11	Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances and all resolutions or parts of
