3 4 5 6 7 8 9	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR TAXATION OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WESTON TO FUND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023.
11 12 13	WHEREAS, First, the City of Weston is a municipality located in Broward County, Florida; and
14 15 16	WHEREAS, Second, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, a public hearing on the City of Weston's final millage rate for Fiscal Year 2023 was held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 21, 2022, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida; and
17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, Third, pursuant to Section 200.065(5)(a)1, Florida Statutes, a rate of not more than 110 percent of the rolled-back rate based on the previous year's maximum millage rate, adjusted for change in per capita Florida personal income, may be adopted if approved by a two-thirds vote of the membership of the governing body of the county, municipality, or independent district.
22 23 24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:
25 26	<u>Section 1:</u> The foregoing recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.
27 28 29 30	Section 2: The final millage rate approved and adopted for the taxation of all real and personal property lying within the boundaries of the City of Weston, Florida shall be 3.3464 mills per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value for the Fiscal Year 2023.
31 32 33 34	Section 3: The percentage by which the millage rate to be levied is 9.93% above the rolled back rate of 3.0442 mills [computed pursuant to F.S. 200.065 (1)] as set forth herein.
35 36 37	Section 4: This Resolution is adopted by a two-thirds vote of the membership of the governing body pursuant to F.S. 200.065(5)(a)1.
38 39 40	Section 5: This final millage rate of 3.3464 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value is for the calendar year 2022 to fund the expenses for the Fiscal Year commencing October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023.
41 42 43 44	Section 6: The City Clerk is directed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Broward County Property Appraiser, the Broward County Revenue Collector, and the Florida Department of Revenue.
