ORDINANCE NO. 2023 –**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH,
FLORIDA, INCREASING ALL LOCAL BUSINESS TAX
RECEIPT FEES BY FIVE PERCENT; PROVIDING FOR
CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes allows municipalities to increase the Local Business Tax by five (5%) percent every two years by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach Local Business Tax Receipt fees were last increased by the City Commission pursuant to Ordinance #2021-011 on August 4, 2021 for Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes requires an increase be enacted by at least a majority plus one vote of the Commission; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends increasing all Local Business Tax Receipt Fees by five percent to support the increased cost of regulating businesses, occupations, and professions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Local Business Tax Receipt Fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit "1A" and made part hereof be amended to reflect a five percent increase in all fees and the resulting fee booklet be amended accordingly.

SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of such conflict.

38 **SECTION 3. Severability.** Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a
39 court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the
40 ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

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42 **SECTION 4. Effective date.** This Ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2023.
