11	WHEREAS, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes allows municipalities to increase the
12	Local Business Tax by five (5%) percent every two years by ordinance; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach Local Business Tax Receipt fees were last
15	increased by the City Commission pursuant to Ordinance #2021-011 on August 4, 2021 for
16	Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes requires an increase be enacted by at
19	least a majority plus one vote of the Commission; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, City Administration recommends increasing all Local Business Tax Receipt
22	Fees by five percent to support the increased cost of regulating businesses, occupations, and
23	professions; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that the City
26	Administration's recommendations are in the best interest of the City and its residents.
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
28	OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
29	
30	SECTION 1. The Local Business Tax Receipt Fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit
31	"1A" and made part hereof be amended to reflect a five percent increase in all fees and the
32	resulting fee booklet be amended accordingly.
33	
34	SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the City
35	of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to the
36	extent of such conflict.
37	

38	SECTION 3. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a
39	court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the
40	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.
41	
42	SECTION 4. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 2023.
