SUMMARY EXPLANATION & BACKGROUND:
 The current rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses went into effect on October 1, 2017 (Ordinance No 2017-03). Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes, permits municipalities to increase, by Ordinance, the rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by up to five percent every other year, provided that the increase must be enacted by at least a majority plus one vote of the governing body.
 The City desires to amend the City Code to increase rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by five percent effective October 1, 2024.

**CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA
ORDINANCE NO. 2024-__**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, BY AMENDING SECTION 40.01, "PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAX" OF CHAPTER 40, "BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS," INCREASING THE BUSINESS TAX RATES BY FIVE PERCENT EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2024 FOR ENGAGING IN BUSINESS WITHIN THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, First, Section 205.042, Florida Statutes, grants a municipality the authority to levy a business tax for the privilege of engaging in or managing any business, profession, or occupation within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Second, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes, permits municipalities to increase, by Ordinance, the rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by up to five percent every other year, provided that the increase must be enacted by at least a majority plus one vote of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, Third, the current rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses went into effect on October 1, 2017 (Ordinance No. 2017-03); and

WHEREAS, Fourth, it is the intent of the City Commission to amend the Code to increase the rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by five percent effective October 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Fifth, business taxes fund expenses in the City's General Fund which is predominantly comprised of expenses related to public safety services; and

WHEREAS, Sixth, business taxes also reduce the City's reliance on ad valorem property taxes to fund General Fund expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Seventh, the City Commission finds that this legislation is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:

Section 1. The foregoing Whereas clauses are ratified and incorporated as the legislative intent and factual findings underlying this Ordinance.

Section 2. Amendment to Chapter 40.

Section 40.01 of Chapter 40, "Business Tax Receipts," of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Weston, is amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 40. BUSINESS TAX RECEIPTS.

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1 **Section 3. Codification.**

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3 It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of this Ordinance become and
4 be made part of the City Code, and that the Sections of this Ordinance and Code may be renumbered
5 or relettered and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section" or such other appropriate word
6 or phrase to accomplish such intentions.

8 **Section 4. Severability.**

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10 Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or other part of this Ordinance be
11 declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity
12 of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

14 **Section 5. Conflict.**

16 That all Sections or parts of Sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances or parts of
17 Ordinances, and all Resolutions, or parts of Resolutions, in conflict with this ordinance are repealed
18 to the extent of such conflict.

20 **Section 6. Effective Date.**

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22 This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and adoption and shall begin to apply
23 for Business Tax Receipts valid for the Fiscal Year commencing October 1, 2024.
