TITLE:

An Ordinance of the City of Weston, Florida, amending the Code of Ordinances of the City, by amending Section 40.01^h, "Payment of Business Tax" of Chapter 40, "Business Tax Receipts," increasing the Business Tax rates by five percent effective October 1, 2024 for engaging in business within the City; and providing for an effective date.

Public Hearing and First Reading

SUMMARY EXPLANATION & BACKGROUND:

The current rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses went into effect on October 1, 201[†] (Ordinance No 201[†]7-03). Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes, permits municipalities to increase, by Ordinance, the rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by up to five percent every other year, provided that the increase must be enacted by at least a majority plus one vote of the governing body.

The City desires to amend the City Code to increase rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by five percent effective October 1, 2024.

10 11	WHEREAS, First, Section 205.042, Florida Statutes, grants a municipality the authority to levy	
12	a business tax for the privilege of engaging in or managing any business, profession, or occupation	
13	within its jurisdiction; and

15	WHEREAS, Second, Section 205.0535(4), Florida Statutes, permits municipalities to increase,	
16	by Ordinance, the rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by up to five percent every	
17	other year, provided that the increase must be enacted by at least a majority plus one vote of the	
18	governing body; and

20	WHEREAS, Third, the current rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses went into	
21	effect on October 1, 2017 (Ordinance No. 2017-03); and	
22 23	WHEREAS, Fourth, it is the intent of the City Commission to amend the Code to increase the	
23	rates of business taxes for all categories of businesses by five percent effective October 1, 2024; and

26	WHEREAS, Fifth, business taxes fund expenses in the City's General Fund which is	
27	predominantly comprised of expenses related to public safety services; and

29	WHEREAS, Sixth, business taxes also reduce the City's reliance on ad valorem property taxes	
30	to fund General Fund expenditures; and

32	WHEREAS, Seventh, the City Commission finds that this legislation is in the best interest of
