- 6.1 **MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FLORIDA GAMING CONTROL COMMISSION** -RESOLUTION 2025-106 APPROVING A LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA GAMING CONTROL COMMISSION, DIVISION OF GAMING ENFORCEMENT; AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Synopsis: Approves a Mutual Aid Agreement with the Florida Gaming Control Commission, Division of Gaming Enforcement to combat illegal gambling.

- 7.1 **SINGLE/SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE APPROVAL PANASONIC CONNECT -** RESOLUTION 2025-109 APPROVING THE SINGLE/SOLE SOURCE PANASONIC CONNECT PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A TOUGHBOOK SUBSCRIPTION FOR THE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026; AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Synopsis: Approves a five-year single/sole source purchase with Panasonic Connect for the Toughbooks and accessories in the amount of \$71,585.02 annually; \$45,867.39 (Police Department) \$25,717.63 (Fire Department)
- 7.2 WORK ORDER APPROVAL AND BUDGET TRANSFER PASSERO ASSOCIATES, LLC -RESOLUTION 2025-110 APPROVING PASSERO ASSOCIATES, LLC WORK ORDER 25-115A FOR PHASE 1 OF THE AMELIA RIVERFRONT RESTAURANT DEMOLITION AND REDEVELOPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$266,290; APPROVING A BUDGET TRANSFER; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.. Synopsis: Approves Passero Associates, LLC Work Order 25-115A for the completion of design, engineering, permitting, and bid services for the demolition of the Amelia Riverfront Restaurant in an amount not to exceed \$266,290.
- 7.3 INTENT TO REIMBURSE AND PURSUE FUTURE TAX EXEMPT FINANCING RESOLUTION 2025-111 DECLARING ITS OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROJECT (AS DEFINED HEREIN) WITH PROCEEDS OF A FUTURE TAX-EXEMPT FINANCING; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN INCIDENTAL ACTIONS; PROVIDING FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution does not obligate the City to incur a debt obligation in the future; it offers flexibility by preserving the City's ability to tax-exempt finance certain prior to capital expenditures, so liquidity can be replenished most cost-effectively.
- 7.4 CHANGE ORDER APPROVAL THOMAS & HUTTON RESOLUTION 2025-112 APPROVING THOMAS & HUTTON CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ADDITIONAL SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR THE AREA 6 STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,725.00; AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. - 7.5 **PROPOSAL APPROVAL AND BUDGET TRANSFER BLD SERVICES, LLC** RESOLUTION 2025-113 APPROVING A PROPOSAL FROM BLD SERVICES, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$113,300 FOR THE REHABILITATION OF PORTIONS OF THE CITY'S GRAVITY SEWER SYSTEM (PROJECT #25031) BY WAY OF A "PIGGYBACK" AGREEMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF BOCA RATON, FLORIDA; APPROVING PROJECT FUNDING REALLOCATION; AUTHORIZING ADMINISTRATIVE CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; AUTHORIZING EXECUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. Synopsis: Approves the proposal from BLD Services, LLC to perform CIPP lining rehabilitation services for sanitary sewer lines in an amount not to exceed \$113,300 by way of piggyback agreement to City of Boca Raton, Florida Contract #2022-021 and project funding reallocation to cover the cost.

 - A THREE (3) MINUTE TIME LIMIT MAY BE IMPOSED FOR ALL SPEAKERS (EXCEPT IN A QUASI-JUDICIAL HEARING). A "REQUEST TO SPEAK" FORM IS AVAILABLE ON THE COUNTER AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE COMMISSION CHAMBERS. THE FORM SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THE CITY CLERK UPON COMPLETION.
 - THE MAYOR WILL DETERMINE THE ORDER OF THE SPEAKERS AND MAY IMPOSE MORE RESTRICTIVE TIME LIMITS.
 - ONE PERSON WILL SPEAK AT A TIME AND ADDRESS COMMENTS TO THE MAYOR, NOT INDIVIDUAL CITY COMMISSION MEMBERS.
 - THE CITY COMMISSION MAY ASK QUESTIONS OF SPEAKERS WHO WILL HAVE ONE MINUTE TO RESPOND. ADDITIONAL TIME MAY BE GRANTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MAYOR OR BY A MOTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION.
 - SPEAKERS MAY FILE COPIES OF THEIR REMARKS WITH THE CITY CLERK WHO WILL MAKE THEM AVAILABLE TO THE COMMISSION.
 - MULTI-MEDIA PRESENTATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK NO LATER THAN THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE MEETING.
 - FERNANDINA BEACH CITIZENS WILL SPEAK BEFORE NONRESIDENTS AND SPEAKERS WILL LIMIT REMARKS TO THE SPECIFIC SUBJECT MATTER.
 - DISCUSSION DIRECTION ACTIONS ITEMS MAY BE ACTED UPON BY THE CITY COMMISSION BY EITHER A MOTION AND VOTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ROBERTS RULES OF ORDER, OR BY A CONSENSUS OF THE CITY COMMISSION.
 - PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 95-32, IF AN ITEM IS NOT ON THE AGENDA IT REQUIRES A FOUR-FIFTHS VOTE OF THE CITY COMMISSION DECLARING THE ITEM AN EMERGENCY BEFORE ACTION CAN BE TAKEN.
 - *QUASI-JUDICIAL* DENOTES THAT THE ITEM MUST BE CONDUCTED AS A QUASI-JUDICIAL HEARING IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY COMMISSION ESTABLISHED PROCEDURE AND FLORIDA STATUTES. ANY PERSON WISHING TO APPEAL ANY QUASI-JUDICIAL DECISION MADE BY THE COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO ANY MATTER CONSIDERED AT SUCH MEETING OR HEARING WILL NEED A RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS, AND, FOR SUCH PURPOSES, MAY NEED TO ENSURE THAT A VERBATIM RECORD OF THE PROCEEDINGS IS MADE, WHICH RECORD INCLUDES THE TESTIMONY AND EVIDENCE UPON WHICH THE APPEAL IS MADE.
 - AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MAYOR, A RECESS MAY BE SCHEDULED EVERY NINETY MINUTES.
