A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA, FLORIDA, SETTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 8.9797 MILLS FOR COMPUTATION OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF OPA-LOCKA, FLORIDA AS REQUIRED BY LAW FOR THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR THE FIRST HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE AND PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, provides that a taxing authority shall advise the Property Appraiser and Tax Collector of the proposed millage rate, the current year rolled-back rate and the date, time and place of the first budget hearing, at which time a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the tentative budget for the upcoming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Opa-Locka has recommended a proposed millage rate of rate of 8.9797 mills for Fiscal Year 2025-2026, commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OPA- LOCKA, FLORIDA:

**<u>SECTION 1.</u>** The recitals to the preamble herein are incorporated by reference.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The proposed tax levy and millage rate for the City of Opa-Locka, Florida for Fiscal Year 2025-2026, commencing October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026, is hereby proposed to be 8.9797 mills, which is \$8.9797 of property taxes per \$1,000 of assessed property value within the City of Opa-Locka. This represents a 11.25% increase over the rolled-back rate of 8.0720 mills, which is \$8.0720 of property taxes per \$1,000 of assessed property value.

## **Short Title:**

Adoption of Preliminary Millage Rate and Establishing Date, Time and Place for First Budget Hearing

## **Staff Summary:**

The City is required to adopt a proposed millage rate, establish the date, time and place for the initial September hearing, to be entered into the State TRIM (Truth in Millage) system no later than August 4, 2025. Staff recommends a millage rate of 8.9797 mills for FY 26.

Staff further recommends that the first budget hearing be conducted at a Special Commission Meeting on Tuesday, September 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. Although the first City budget hearing is normally conducted prior to the first Regular Commission Meeting in September, the Miami-Dade School Board will be conducting their second budget hearing on September 10<sup>th</sup>, and the State TRIM Statute prohibits the City from conducting a budget
