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Section 2: That for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2025 and ending on September 30, 2026, a tax of 8.3500 mills, which is 6.53% more than the rolled-back rate of 7.8381 mills, on the dollar shall be, and is levied and shall be collected on all real property and tangible business personal property within the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, not specifically designated as homestead property or owned by the municipality and/or expressly exempted by the laws of the Constitution of the State of Florida for the purpose of raising funds for the improvements and government of the City, and for the payment of its obligations and expenses, and for the purpose of carrying out the purpose and duties granted and imposed by the City Charter and Code. Said real property and tangible business personal property being specifically set forth in Section 1 hereof and valued in the amount of \$9,513,098,706 subject to final approval of the Value Adjustment Board.

44 **Section 3:** As provided by Florida Statutes Section 200.065(5), upon notification from the
45 Property Appraiser of any aggregate change in the certified assessment roll, the City Manager is
46 hereby authorized to certify to the Property Appraiser, within three (3) days of notification, an
47 adjusted millage rate which shall be such that taxes computed by applying the adopted rate against
48 the certified taxable value are equal to the taxable value on the roll to be extended.

49
50 **Section 4:** The millage rate is 8.3500 mills which is more than the rolled-back rate of
51 7.8381 mills by 6.53%.

53 **Section 5:** If any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this Ordinance is for any
54 reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any
55 remaining portion of this Ordinance.

56
57 **Section 6:** That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances
58 or parts of Ordinances and all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions, in conflict herewith are and the
59 same are hereby repealed to extent of such conflict.

61 **Section 7:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective October 1, 2025 upon its
62 passage and adoption.
