

43 **Section 2:** That if any section, phrase, sentence or portion of this ordinance is for any
44 reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall
45 be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the
46 validity of the remaining portions thereof.

47 **Section 3:** That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Ordinances, all Ordinances
48 or parts of Ordinances, and all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the
49 same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
50

51 **Section 4:** That this Ordinance shall not be codified.

52 **Section 5:** That the adopted rates shall be implemented in two equal annual increments
53 effective ninety (90) days after the effective date of this Ordinance.

54 **Section 6:** That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage
55 and adoption.
