Proposed Resolution No. R26-096- Approve a Piggyback Agreement with RedSpeed Florida, LLC, utilizing the City of New Port Richey contract RFP #RFP25-020, for a combined Red Light Camera Enforcement and School Zone Speed Detection Program at the City.

Requested Action: Staff recommends approval of Proposed Resolution No. R26-096.

Explanation of Request: Red light cameras and school zone speed cameras are automated traffic enforcement systems designed to improve public safety by reducing speeding and signal violations. Red light cameras capture vehicles that enter intersections after a signal has turned red, while school zone speed cameras monitor vehicle speeds in designated school zones, both issuing citations to registered vehicle owners without requiring direct police presence.

Research consistently supports the effectiveness of these systems. Red light cameras have been shown to reduce fatal intersection crashes, and school zone speed camera programs have demonstrated significant reductions in speeding near schools — protecting children, pedestrians, and cyclists who are among the most vulnerable road users. Automated enforcement also supplements traditional policing by providing consistent, around-the-clock compliance without diverting officer resources from other public safety priorities.

As municipalities seek cost-effective and data-driven approaches to traffic safety, these camera programs represent a proven strategy for reducing crashes, lowering injury severity, and reinforcing safe driving behaviors in high-risk areas. To create efficiencies, the City of Boynton Beach Police Department is proposing to consolidate both services into a single program — streamlining administration, vendor management, and enforcement operations while maximizing the safety impact for the community.

To accomplish this, the City of Boynton Beach's Police Department is proposing to piggyback off the existing agreement between the City of New Port Richey and RedSpeed Florida, LLC. On January 20, 2026, the City of New Port Richey awarded RFP 25-020 to RedSpeed USA following a competitive procurement process in which six sealed proposals were evaluated. RedSpeed was selected as the most qualified firm to administer both the Red-Light Camera Traffic Safety Program and the School Zone Speed Detection Traffic Safety Program. The resulting five-year agreement provides a turnkey solution covering installation, maintenance, violation processing, citation management, and customer support for both programs — with school zone speed enforcement structured as a revenue-share model and red light

enforcement operating under a fixed monthly fee with a net-zero-cost guarantee to the municipality.

This purchase and contract will be made pursuant to the Piggyback Exemption authorized by the City's Purchasing Policy. Piggyback contracts provide significant value to the City of Boynton Beach by offering a cost-effective, efficient procurement method. Leveraging competitively awarded contracts from other governmental entities allows the City to avoid issuing its own formal solicitation, which can be time-consuming and resource-intensive. This process accelerates access to needed goods and services while benefiting from favorable pricing achieved through economies of scale. Additionally, piggyback agreements utilize vendors who have already undergone a rigorous competitive evaluation, reducing administrative workload and mitigating risks associated with vendor performance. Overall, piggyback procurement streamlines operations, saves taxpayer dollars, and supports timely and effective service delivery for City departments and residents. Negotiations with RedSpeed Florida, LLC yielded pricing more favorable than the piggyback contract rate, producing additional savings for the City of Boynton Beach.

It should be noted to the commission that after negotiations with Procurement Services and the Boynton Beach Police Department, Redspeed has agreed to waive the first month of red-light camera service fees, representing a savings of \$69,300 for the City.

How will this affect city programs or services? Implementation of the Red-Light Camera Traffic Safety Program and School Zone Speed Detection Traffic Safety Program will directly enhance the City of Boynton Beach Police Department's traffic safety enforcement capabilities. By automating the detection and citation process for red light violations and school zone speeding, the Police Department will be able to expand enforcement coverage across key corridors and school zones without requiring additional officer deployment. This allows sworn personnel to remain focused on higher-priority public safety functions while automated systems provide consistent, around-the-clock enforcement.

The programs are designed to operate at no net cost to the City, as program expenses are offset by citation revenue generated through violations. This structure protects the City's general fund while delivering enhanced traffic safety infrastructure and services to residents.

Additionally, consolidating both programs under a single vendor and contract reduces administrative burden on City staff, streamlining oversight, reporting, and vendor coordination. The programs will also support broader community safety goals by reducing traffic-related injuries and fatalities near schools and signalized intersections, contributing to a safer environment for students, pedestrians, and motorists throughout Boynton Beach.

Budgeted Item: Yes

Account Line Item and Description: Revenue account 103-0000-354.05-00.

Fiscal Impact: Revenue generated from fines collected will be tracked in a separate account and used for public safety, pursuant to Florida State Statutes.

It should be noted to the commission that, following negotiations with Procurement Services and the Police Department, Redspeed has agreed to waive the first month of red-light camera service fees, resulting in a cost savings of \$69,300 for the City.
