1 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD
2 COUNTY, FLORIDA, PERTAINING TO PORT EVERGLADES TARIFF NO. 12
3 ("TARIFF"); AMENDING SECTION 42.25 OF THE BROWARD COUNTY
4 ADMINISTRATIVE CODE ("ADMINISTRATIVE CODE"); AMENDING TARIFF RATES
5 AND REQUIREMENTS FOR VARIOUS ACTIVITIES AT PORT EVERGLADES;
6 PROVIDING FOR GENERAL UPDATES TO TARIFF TEXT; AND PROVIDING FOR
7 SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE
8 DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County, Florida
11 ("Commission"), desires to amend Section 42.25 of the Broward County Administrative
12 Code, Exhibit 42.A, to revise Tariff No. 12, regarding Tariff rates and requirements, and
13 to provide for general updates to the Tariff text; and

14 WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that the revisions are necessary and
15 in the best interests of Broward County, NOW, THEREFORE,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
17 BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA:

18 Section 1. Tariff No. 12, which is codified as Exhibit 42.A and incorporated in
19 Section 42.25 of the Broward County Administrative Code, is hereby amended as set
20 forth in Attachment A hereto.

21 Section 2. Severability.

22 If any portion of this Administrative Code Resolution is determined by any court to
23 be invalid, the invalid portion will be stricken, and such striking will not affect the validity
24 of the remainder of this Administrative Code Resolution. If any court determines that this
25 Administrative Code Resolution, in whole or in part, cannot be legally applied to any
26 individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance, such determination will not affect the
27 applicability of this Administrative Code Resolution to any other individual, group, entity,
28 property, or circumstance.

29 Section 3. Inclusion in the Broward County Administrative Code.

30 It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this
31 Administrative Code Resolution become part of the Broward County Administrative Code
32 as of the effective date. The sections of this Administrative Code Resolution may be
33 renumbered or relettered and the word "resolution" may be changed to "section," "article,"
34 or such other appropriate word or phrase to the extent necessary to accomplish such
35 intention.

36 Section 4. Effective Date.

37 This Administrative Code Resolution is effective upon adoption.
