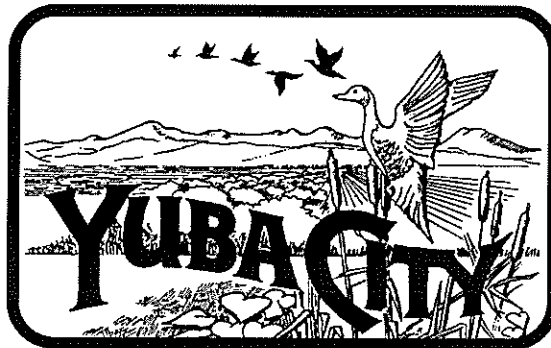

1. Written Requests

Members of the public submitting written requests, at least 24 hours prior to the meeting, will be normally allotted 5 minutes to speak.

2. Appearance of Interested Citizens

Members of the public may address the City Council on items of interest that are within the City's jurisdiction. Individuals addressing general comments are encouraged to limit their statements to 3 minutes.

Consent Calendar

All matters listed under Consent Calendar are considered to be routine and can be enacted in one motion. There will be no separate discussion of these items prior to the time that Council votes on the motion unless members of the City Council, staff or public request specific items to be discussed or removed from the Consent Calendar for individual action.

3. City Council Approval of Minutes of November 4, 2008

Recommendation: Approve the Council meeting minutes of November 4, 2008.

4. Authorization to Formally Apply, Accept and Expend Grant Funding for Training, Governance and Policy Development Relative to the Police Department's Regional Emergency Interoperable Radio System as Funded by the Office of Homeland Security

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution authorizing the application, acceptance and expenditure of a California Office of Homeland Security Training, Governance and Operations Policy Development Grant. Further, authorize the City's Chief Financial Officer to make budget adjustments as necessary.

5. Purchase of Real Property (APN 52-401-014) (RDA)

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Executive Director to execute a Purchase and Sale Agreement and accept a Grant Deed for Real Property located at 454 Stevens Avenue (APN 52-401-014) in Yuba City, and approving a related supplemental appropriation of \$123,000 in Redevelopment Agency Funds.

6. Amendment to City Investment Policy

Recommendation: a) Approve an amendment to the City Investment Policy to provide for the purchase of City and Redevelopment Agency lease and debt obligations exceeding 5 years in maturity.
b) Authorize staff to purchase Yuba City Redevelopment Project 2007 Tax Allocation Bonds for investment in the City's pooled cash portfolio.

Recommendation: Given the fact that the offset in impact fees is not a significant amount, it would be prudent at this time to hold impact fees at their current levels in an effort to stimulate economic activity.

8. Bicycle Transportation Plan

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution adopting the City of Yuba City Bicycle Transportation Plan dated November 2008.

9. Bicycle Transportation Account Grant Application

Recommendation: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Public Works Director to submit an application for the State Bicycle Transportation Account, and if selected, agreeing to the matching funds requirement.

10. Town Center Property – License and Cleanup Agreement with Yuba City Steel Products Company (RDA)

Recommendation: Authorize the Executive Director to enter into a License and Cleanup Agreement with Yuba City Steel Products Company covering environmental investigation and remediation of property

located at 425 Franklin Avenue (AP#52-380-016) owned by the
Redevelopment Agency of the City of Yuba City.
