

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE WAYFINDING SIGN SYSTEM PLAN TO EFFICIENTLY AND SAFELY GUIDE MOTORISTS AND PEDESTRIANS TO KEY PUBLIC FACILITIES INCLUDING CIVIC, CULTURAL, VISITOR AND RECREATIONAL DESTINATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF ORLANDO.

WHEREAS, City staff have prepared certain citywide wayfinding sign evaluation factors and criteria to evaluate and process future destination sign requests; and

WHEREAS, these factors and criteria have been utilized to develop a preliminary location master plan and design for wayfinding signs within downtown Orlando: and

WHEREAS, other requirements will be further developed by City staff after approval by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ORLANDO, ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the Wayfinding Sign System Plan, which includes the wayfinding sign evaluation criteria; preliminary sign location master plan, and the signage design as developed by City staff.

SECTION 2. The City Council also supports the wayfinding sign evaluation criteria, and the signage design to be utilized in determining sign location and design within the City of Orlando.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
